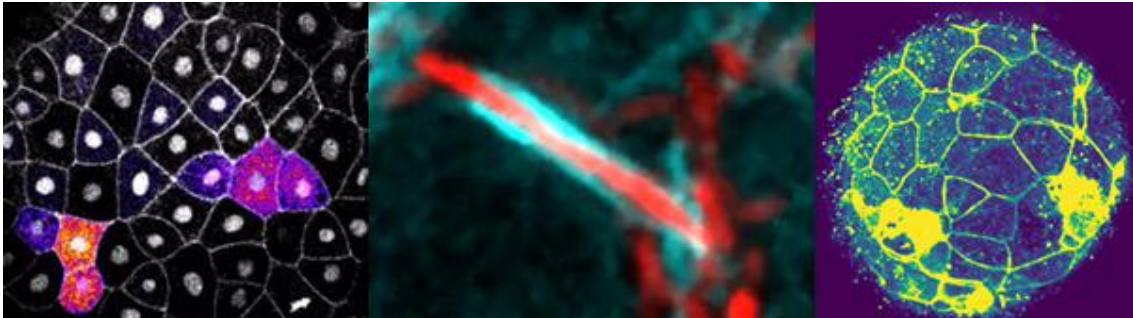




PhD candidate – Embryonic Cell Bioimaging Lab
